Party Themes: (choose one)

- ◆ Little Naturalists (ages 3-4), held year round
Fur, feathers and scales– oh my! We'll talk about the differences between the different kinds of animals through stories, crafts and games– and event meet a live turtle!
- ◆ Reptiles & Amphibians (ages 5-8), held year round
See the difference between reptiles and amphibians. Jump like a frog and make a reptilian craft– then meet a live turtle and snake!
- ◆ Camouflage Critters (ages 5-8), held year round
Learn how animals use camouflage in their habitats through games and crafts. Meet a live turtle! If the weather permits, we'll go outside to see if we can spy any camouflaged animals in the Garden.
- ◆ Diggin' Dinos (ages 5-8), held year round
Become a junior paleontologist during the dno-mite birthday! We'll dig for dinos and other fossils, and make a dino craft to take home.
- ◆ Buggy/Butterfly (ages 5-10) held April–October
Let's get buggy! We'll discuss the basics of insects and compare them to other "bugs." Then grab our nets and bug jars as we explore the Garden for some 6-legged friends! An emphasis on butterflies can be selected for this theme.
- ◆ Pond Explorer (ages 8-12) April– October
What lives in the Garden pond? We'll talk about our pond ecosystem and head outside to get muddy as we use nets to catch tadpoles and fish in the pond!
