RULES:

- Boat must be made out of items that are previously used (that is nothing new except duct tape)
 - ALLOWED: Cardboard or wood, plastic bottles or metal cans, duct tape or twine, natural materials ext.
 - NOT ALLOWED: Parts from "real" boats or toy boats, materials that could easily break off your boat and float away (e.g., Styrofoam packing peanuts), and containers that held pollutants, harsh chemicals, or other potentially hazardous powders or liquids that could harm people or nature.
- Boats may not exceed 18 inches in length and width
- Boats must float for up to 5 minutes to be in the running for the overall winner
- All boats need to be registered and inspected by 3pm on April 30th 2017 at marked registration table
