



# Cape Fear Botanical Garden

## Adult Tours

*Take a tour through our main garden areas. Learn about the natural history of the Cape Fear region and the history of the Garden itself. Explore the Garden's flowers and other plants. Peak season is March through October; however tours are available year-round during business hours.*

### Frequently Asked Questions:

**How much do tours cost?** Tours are \$20 for groups up to 20, plus applicable admission for each visitor. General admission is \$10 or \$9 for military and seniors over 65. Garden members are free.

**Is there a group rate?** Groups of more than 25 paying individuals receive a discounted rate when they schedule a Garden visit in advance. Group rate is \$8 per adult and \$4 per child.

**How do we book a tour?** An online registration can be found at [capefearbg.org](http://capefearbg.org), under the education tab. Please book your tour at least one week in advance.

**May we bring food?** You may bring picnic lunches, however catered food must be coordinated through the Garden. We do have snacks and drinks available in the Garden Gift Shop.

**Do we have to walk?** Golf carts must be reserved in advance and may be used in addition to or instead of walking. Each golf cart is \$25 per hour and can carry three riders with a Garden-provided driver.

**Are persons using wheelchairs able to take the tours?** Standard wheelchairs can travel most paths and trails as long as the pusher is able to help negotiate occasional obstacles.

**What should we wear?** Soil, water, and mud are the norm- and all tours are outdoors. **Please dress for the weather** and wear closed-toed shoes. Please refrain from wearing scented perfumes or body sprays that may attract insects!

**What if it rains?** Tours are conducted outdoors in all but severe weather. If severe weather is present, an attempt to reschedule your group may be made.
