EXPLORE & LEARN

Guided Garden Tours

Birding for Beginners - Enjoy an hour of bird watching in the Garden, while learning to identify common local birds. Binoculars and field guides are provided.

Heritage Farm History Tour - This tour provides a unique chance to explore life on a local NC farm in the late 1800's, including a fully furnished historical farm house.

Cape Fear River Hike - This tour through the woodland trail along the banks of the Cape Fear River will inspire wonder with giant cypress trees, native wild flowers and amazing river views.

Butterfly Stroll - The Garden's Pollinator Garden is home to a wonderful array of native butterflies and colorful spring and summer flowers. Please note that peak season for this tour is April - September.
